MAKE A CONE ZONE

Use cones or triangles to **direct traffic**
away from you and your vehicle

5.

**ASSESS
THE RISK**

**Return to your
vehicle, or if
there are haz-
ards, stay far
off to the side
of the road**



Place triangles at
the rear of truck

100 feet

Place one triangle
at the front of truck

HAZARDS

- Slips, Trips or Falls
- Inhalation of Vapours or Smoke
- Musculoskeletal Injuries (MSI's)
- Stress

- Cuts or Burns
- Fire
- Moving Vehicles and Traffic

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- Hi-Vis Vest
- Gloves
- Safety Footwear

TOOLS

- Fire Extinguisher
- First Aid Kit
