Responsibilities

Employer/Management Responsibilities

- Ensure the health and safety of all employees
- Establish health and safety programs, policies, and procedures as per regulatory requirements
- Ensure each employee is made aware of all known or foreseeable hazards in their area of work
- Provide employees all training, information, instruction, and supervision necessary
- Establish and cooperate with the Joint Health and Safety Committee
- Ensure workers have access to safety regulations and other relevant resources
- Conduct an annual review of the safety program and develop annual safety improvement plan.
- Hold an annual company-wide health and safety meeting to communicate safety policies, objectives, performance, and continuous improvement goals.

Supervisor Responsibilities

- Ensure the health and safety of all workers under their direct supervision
- Ensure supervised workers are made aware of all known and foreseeable hazards



- Be knowledgeable of applicable legislation and regulations relevant to the work being supervised
- Actively promote the safety program and encourage safe work habits

Worker Responsibilities

- Take all reasonable precautions to protect themselves and others affected by their actions at work
- Use and wear all protective equipment, clothing and devices as required by the employer
- Do not work while impaired by drugs, alcohol, fatigue, or other causes
- Report any violations to regulatory requirements or workplace hazards
- Follow all established health and safety procedures and company rules
- Know how to access applicable safety legislation
